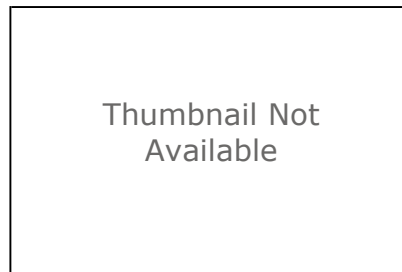

Sewer Manholes

Description

The Onondaga County Manhole geographic dataset was created by the Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection (OCDWEP) in early 2014. This dataset was designed to provide users with the general location of sanitary sewer manhole features that connect two or more pipes and control the flow of sewage and storm water in the Onondaga County Sanitary District. Manholes were inputted to the dataset based on information obtained from maps produced by various consultants and engineering firms ranging from the early 1900s to present day. A subset of manholes were later located using survey grade GPS technologies and adjusted for positional accuracy.
